*Miniature designs have a maximum of $12.7 \mathrm{~cm}\left(5^{\prime \prime}\right)$ in any direction. For good proportion, the container should not exceed $3.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ in height.
*Small designs range from 14 cm to $25.4 \mathrm{~cm}\left(51 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$ to $\left.10^{\prime \prime}\right)$ and must not exceed $25.4 \mathrm{~cm}\left(10^{\prime \prime}\right)$
*Mass designs use a large quantity of plant material
*Wayside designs use common, plentiful flowers, foliage, fungi and/or weeds (Goldenrod, Queen Anne's lace, etc.)
*Freestyle design has no rules
