| 1. Tulip—Single, any colour | 1 bloom |

| 4. Hellebores (Lenten Rose) | 1 stem |
| 5. Lily of the Valley | 1 stem |
| 6. Narcissus (Daffodil) large cup | 3 stems |
| 7. Narcissus—small cup | 1 stem, stalk, spray |
| 8. Narcissus—double | 1 scape |
| 9. Hyacinth | 1 scape |
| 10. Muscari (Grape Hyacinth) | 1 scape |
| 11. Flowering Branch—under 36" | 1 branch |
| 12. Primula (Primrose) | 3 stems |
| 13. Scilla—any colour | 3 stems |
| 14. Any other spring flower | 1 stem, stalk, spray |

Section B: House Plants—One Pot

15. House plant grown primarily for foliage
16. House plant grown primarily for flowers
17. African Violet—any species
18. Orchid—any variety
19. Cactus or Succulent
20. Herb plant over-wintered indoors
21. Any plant grown as a miniature type

Section C: Design

Theme: Flowering Melodies

22. **Crescendo** — a modern, creative design using only a few components with bold colours
23. **Jazzy Jewels** —a miniature* design
24. **Musical Notes** —a rhythmic design using repetition
25. **Strike Up the Band** —a design using only foliage

*Miniature designs have a maximum of 12.7 cm (5") in any direction. For good proportion, the container should not exceed 3.5 cm (1-1/2") in height.

*Small designs range from 14cm to 25.4 cm(5 1/2" to 10") and must not exceed 25.4cm(10")

*Mass designs use a large quantity of plant material

*Wayside designs use common, plentiful flowers, foliage, fungi and/or weeds (Goldenrod, Queen Anne's lace, etc.)

*Freestyle design has no rules
