Section B: House Plants—One Pot

- 15. House plant grown primarily for foliage
- 16. House plant grown primarily for flowers
- 17. African Violet—any species
- 18. Orchid—any variety

14. Any other spring flower

- 19. Cactus or Succulent
- 20. Herb plant over-wintered indoors
- 21. Any plant grown as a miniature type

Section C: Design

Theme: Flowering Melodies

- 22. Crescendo a modern, creative design using only a few components with bold colours
- 23. **Jazzy Jewels** —a miniature* design
- 24. **Musical Notes** —a rhythmic design using repetition
- 25. **Strike Up the Band** —a design using only foliage
- *Miniature designs have a maximum of 12.7 cm (5") in any direction. For good proportion, the container should not exceed 3.5 cm (1-1/2") in height.
- *Small designs range from 14cm to 25.4 cm(5 1/2" to 10") and must not exceed 25.4cm(10")
- *Mass designs use a large quantity of plant material
- *Wayside designs use common, plentiful flowers, foliage, fungi and/or weeds (Goldenrod, Queen Anne's lace, etc.)
- *Freestyle design has no rules
